We aim to take you on a journey that values local treasures and offers a wild exploration.


It's hard to put into words the feeling you get upon discovering this place, but everyone agrees that it's magical!

## **DESIGN & ARCHITECTURE**


Vicky Charles and Julia Corden, the architects of Charles & Co, have left their mark at L'Alpaga, their first collaboration with Beaumier. They have adopted an approach aimed at preserving the interior architecture while integrating the natural majesty of the surroundings.

The renovated rooms evoke the authentic charm of alpine chalets, blending contemporary comfort with traditional elements. Wood paneling and linen fabrics create a warm atmosphere, while each decorative detail resonates with emotion. The space invites relaxation and reflection.

Renowned landscape architect Gwenaëlle Grandjean has added her personal touch with a contemporary herbarium for L'Alpaga. Her large-scale works capture the diversity of the surrounding flora, providing a complete immersion in nature.

Artist Gabriel Micheletti has enhanced the walls of L'Alpaga with his luminous mountain landscapes. He shares: «Drawing landscapes is a pretext to stop for a long time, to wait, to reach the visionary state that incorporates me into the rhythm of geology. It would be enough for me to become the smallest fragment of this landscape to gain eternity.»

The Bar de l'Alpaga, a true ambassador of the local terroir, awaits you from 10:30 AM to 11:00 PM, offering breathtaking views of the snowy peaks. Aromatic herbs, garden flowers, and local spirits on one side, Savoyard snacks on the other, create a harmonious blend to delight even the most discerning palates.

From the large windows of the Bistrot, the region reveals itself in all its winter splendor. The generous and authentic offering begins at 7:30 AM and extends until 10:30 AM, featuring cold and hot buffets showcasing the best of local products: fresh juices, aromatic coffees, artisanal yogurts, moist cakes, savory charcuterie, eggs prepared in various styles... 


## **LOCAL**






















## **BEAUMIER**
